### [ANTIBODY SPECIFITY]

The antibody is a rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against vWA1. It has been selected for its ability to recognize vWA1 in immunohistochemical staining and western blotting.

Western blotting: 1:100-400

Immunocytochemistry in formalin fixed cells: 1:100-500




Immunohistochemistry in formalin fixed frozen section: 1:100-500

# [CONTENTS]

**Form & Buffer:** Supplied as solution form in PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.02% NaN<sub>3</sub>, 50% glycerol.

# [ QUALITY CONTROL ]

**Content:** The quality control contains recombinant vWA1 (Ser42~Val289) disposed in loading buffer.

Usage: 10uL per well when 3,3'-Diaminobenzidine(DAB) as the substrate.

5uL per well when used in enhanced chemilumescent (ECL).

**Note:** The quality control is specifically manufactured as the positive control. Not used for other purposes.

**Loading Buffer:** 100mM Tris(pH8.8), 2% SDS, 200mM NaCl, 50% glycerol, BPB 0.01%, NaN<sub>3</sub> 0.02%.

# [STORAGE]

Store at 4°C for frequent use. Stored at -20°C to -80°C in a manual defrost freezer for one year without detectable loss of activity. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
