[ANTIBODY SPECIFICITY]

Anti OTUB1 is a rabbit polyclonal antibody raised against rat OTUB1. This antibody has been selected for its ability to recognize rat OTUB1 in immunohistochemical staining and western blotting, non cross-reactive with other members of the family.

[APPLICATIONS]

Western blotting: 1:100-400

Immunocytochemistry in formalin fixed cells: 1:100-500

Immunohistochemistry in formalin fixed frozen section: 1:100-500

Immunohistochemistry in paraffin section: 1:50-200

Optimal working dilutions must be determined by end user.

[CONTENTS]

Form & Buffer: Supplied as solution form in PBS, pH 7.4, containing 0.02%Na₃N, 50% glycerol.

[STORAGE]

Store at 4°C for frequent use. Stored at -20°C to -80°C in a manual defrost freezer for one year without detectable loss of activity. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
